The City of Omaha would like to take this opportunity to update you on the reconstruction of 48<sup>th</sup> Street from Harrison to Q Street project.

At this time, construction continues on the remaining work along 48<sup>th</sup> Street between Monroe & Y Street. On Friday April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026, 48<sup>th</sup> Street between Polk and Monroe Street is scheduled to be closed. Monroe and Drexel between 48<sup>th</sup> & 46<sup>th</sup> Street will be accessible from the East but closed at 48<sup>th</sup> Street. The 48<sup>th</sup> & Polk Street intersection will remain open at this time but 48<sup>th</sup> Street between Polk & Drexel will be closed to through traffic. Additional notifications will be provided as needed as work progresses to Harrison Street.

If you live along 48<sup>th</sup> Street between Polk and Monroe Street, it is anticipated your property will be affected as the work progresses.

Please do not move or otherwise tamper with temporary fencing, barricades or other warning devices. They are essential for identifying potentially unsafe conditions. If applicable, please advise others (including children) at your location of the upcoming work and the need to exercise due care when in areas near or adjacent to the construction areas and activities.
